After many months of conversation and processing, I am writing to officially tender my resignation from my position as Town Administrator and Town Clerk. This decision did not come lightly and though I join the recent wave of municipal managers who are stepping down after a year of service, I assure you it is due to personal reasons. I wanted to honor my contract with a 30+ day notice and respect my staff and community as they will need some time to transition. My last day will be August 11.
