## Application Instructions

1. For renewal applications, the fields have been pre-populated with the 2024 permit information. **Please review it for accuracy and note any corrections.**
2. You can confirm your GPS location by visiting <https://bluehillme.gov/moorings> and searching for your name or zooming in to the area in which your mooring is located. The GPS coordinates of the cursor (or a selected mooring) are shown in the lower right-hand corner of the mooring map.
3. You must recertify property ownership/residency every year. If you check “yes” to either question, you may be asked to demonstrate the basis for your selections.
4. Complete, at a minimum, the fields marked with a single red asterisk( \*).
5. The other Ground Tackle information will be required in 2026, so consider collecting this information now.
6. The Watercraft Information is optional, but providing it can be very helpful to the Harbormaster in the event there is an issue with the vessel (accident, collision, parted from mooring tackle, etc.).

## Limited-Value Fields in Moorings Application
