General Assistance Notice

The Town of Blue Hill administers a General Assistance program for the support of the poor. Pursuant to Title 22 M.R.S.A. § 4305, the municipal officers have adopted an ordinance establishing that program. A copy of this ordinance and relevant statutes is available for public inspection at the Town Office during normal business hours, as well as online at bluehillme.gov.

Persons wishing to apply for General Assistance may contact the Town Office to schedule an appointment. Applications are accepted during all normal operating hours. In an emergency, contact the Hancock County Sheriff's Office at (207) 667-7575.

The Town's General Assistance Administrator must issue a written decision regarding eligibility to all applicants within 24 hours of receiving an application.
